

## **Steven Anthony Behar, CD #19 (2009)**

### **1. Failing to accurately report cash receipts**

**VNP**

Campaigns are required to report all receipts, deposit them in the account listed on the candidate's Certification, and provide the Board with the deposit slips. *See* Admin. Code §§ 3-703(1)(d), (g), (6), (10); Board Rules 1-04(a), (b), 2-06(a), 3-03(c), 4-01(a), (b)(1).

The Campaign reported cash receipts of \$3,430, but documented cash deposits of only \$3,075, a difference of \$355. This is a cash variance of 10.35%.

The Board did not assess a penalty for this violation.

### **2. Failing to document a specific transaction**

**VNP**

Campaigns must maintain records, such as copies of checks, bills and other documentation, that enable the Campaign Finance Board to verify the contributions and expenditures reported in the candidate's disclosure statements. *See* Admin. Code §§ 3-703(1)(d), (g); Board Rule 4-01(a), (b)(2). Campaigns are required to furnish such records to the Campaign Finance Board upon request. *See* Admin. Code §§ 3-703(1)(d), (g).

The Campaign failed to provide documentation concerning the return to the Campaign of a rent deposit of \$1,000, pursuant to a lease agreement for the Campaign office.

The Board did not assess a penalty for this violation.
