## Dear Sir/Madam:

I am writing regarding the issue of payment for ads taken out in newspapers and journals by Council Members.

A recent Citizens Union investigation showed that payment for these advertisements is done through both city monies and campaign funds. I have chosen to use campaign funds. However, on a related issue, I was recently advised by your board that I was not to place information regarding my city offices on my campaign website. The reasons for these instructions are still unclear to me as I was under the impression that private money could be spent to promote city resources, but be that as it may.

The question then becomes, however, may advertisements paid for out of campaign funds contain city office information?

I personally see no problem with this (especially since the use of city money is frowned upon and may soon be illegal) and will continue this practice unless otherwise instructed by you.
