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Notes to Appendices and Data

A ll appendices are limited to candidates for the 1997 citywide elections unless otherwise noted, and data are cumulative for all committees for a given campaign. All data for participants in this report and in all appendices, are from the New York City Campaign Finance Board's Campaign Finance Information System ("CFIS") as of April 30, 1998. The CFIS database is, however, subject to change as a result of ongoing audits and additional amendments to filings received from candidates. Figures are based upon what is reported to the Board and may not reflect conclusions about the data reached during the audit and enforcement process. Unless otherwise indicated, all formulas in the report are identical to the formulas described in the appendices.

Data for non-participants are based upon State Board of Elections financial disclosure statements required under state law to be submitted to the Board of Elections in the City of New York and made available to the Campaign Finance Board as of April 30, 1998. Non-participant filings are not audited by the CFB. Data for non-participants are included only for purposes of making general comparisons. Among the specific reasons these non-participant totals are *not* directly comparable with participant data are:

- a) The CFB was unable to obtain all New York City Board of Elections ("City BOE") filings required of non-participants' committees covering the entire period of their activity within the 1997 election cycle, particularly filings made early in the cycle. (Note: non-participants' filings do not, of course, reflect presumptions that the CFB uses in framing an election cycle, which for the 1997 elections is, in general, considered to run from 1/12/94-1/11/98, or the bases on which the CFB distinguishes primary and general election periods.)
- b) The totals shown are derived from summary information reported in City BOE filings and are complete only for the City BOE filings that were obtained by the CFB. Missing filings tend to lead to under-inclusive totals. Where a candidate had more than one authorized committee active in the 1997 election cycle, the totals shown here represent the sum of the multiple committees' reported transactions for the filings obtained. Totals for participants are based on detailed transactions and may include transactions (e.g., transfers to and from political party committees) that would not, in general, be included in a non-participant's contribution or expenditure totals.
- c) A number of the filings obtained from the City BOE were not complete disclosure statements. For example, some filings were missing summary or detail pages; others contained illegible information or errors in arithmetic. Various inconsistencies were apparent in how information was reported by non-participants, such as the improper use of certain forms (e.g., schedules for "housekeeping" transactions).

Notes to Appendices and Data

- Some of the City BOE filings covered multiple disclosure periods or included transactions from different disclosure periods.
- d) The manner in which non-participants submit amended disclosure statements is different from the CFB protocols for amendment and resubmission.
- e) Some non-participants' filings may contain information relating to a previous election. This is not indicated in non-participants' filings in a clear and consistent manner. The contribution totals shown do not include surplus funds remaining from a non-participant's previous elections, which would have been available to the non-participant for expenditure in the 1997 election cycle.
- f) The City BOE filings contain various versions of disclosure forms that have been issued by the State Board of Elections. Additional variation among the filings may be the result of changes in the State Board of Elections forms and disclosure instructions over time and the fact that many committees continue to use superseded versions.

Vote totals for all candidates are as provided by the New York City Board of Elections.

APPENDIX A: CAMPAIGN FINANCE PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS IN THE 1997 ELECTIONS

Appendix A presents an alphabetical list of participants by office sought for the 1997 elections. An asterisk indicates that the participant was on the ballot in either the primary or general election. A dagger indicates incumbency.

APPENDIX B: TOTALS FOR CANDIDATES APPEARING ON THE PRIMARY ELECTION BALLOT

This appendix includes data for both participants and non-participants through the first post-primary filing. The first post-primary filing does not necessarily reflect expenditures attributable only to the primary election. In addition, it includes expenditures for any anticipated run-off elections. It shows the candidate's name, participation status, net contributions, public funds payments (participants only), net expenditures, and votes received. Also noted at the district level is whether bonus matching was triggered for that district for campaigns that met the threshold to receive public funds. At the candidate level incumbency is noted. Specific information about the data is indicated in the "Notes" column on the last page of the appendix.

Data for Participants

Net Contributions includes itemized and unitemized monetary contributions, in-kind contributions, transfers received from a party or constituted committee, and advances, less refunds and forgiven loans. This does not include any surplus funds from previous elections; transfers from non-covered committees, which are reported as lump-sum amounts on the disclosure statements; any loans that are deemed contributions because they are outstanding after the last election, taken out after the election, or paid back by a third party; or any bills that are deemed contributions because they are

outstanding for more than 90 days, paid back by a third party, or forgiven. *Net Expenditures* consists of itemized and unitemized expenditure payments, in-kind contributions, transfers to a party or constituted committee, advances on all submitted primary disclosure statements, and outstanding bills from a campaign committee's last submitted primary disclosure statement, less expenditure refunds. *CFB payments* includes disbursed funds to candidates for the primary only.

Data for Non-participants

Totals shown represent cumulative contributions and spending from a candidate's 10-day post-primary filing with the Board of Elections or, if this was unavailable, the latest preceding available statement.

APPENDIX C: TOTALS FOR CANDIDATES APPEARING ON THE GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT

This appendix includes data for both participants and non-participants through the January 15, 1998 periodic statement. It shows the candidate's name, party, participation status, total contributions, public funds payments (for participants only), total expenditures, and votes received. Also noted at the district level is whether bonus matching was triggered for that district for campaigns that met the threshold in either the primary or the general election period. Campaigns that were removed from a primary ballot subsequent to being found eligible for bonus matching are included. At the candidate level incumbency is noted. Specific information about the data is indicated in the "Notes" column on the last page of the appendix.

For those candidates in a primary or run-off or subject to a primary election or run-off election spending limit, financial activity attributable to the primary election and the run-off election is included in these totals and is not distinguished from activity for the general election.

Data for Participants

Net Contributions includes itemized and unitemized monetary contributions, in-kind contributions, transfers received from a party or constituted committee, and advances, less refunds and forgiven loans. This does not include any surplus funds from previous elections; transfers from non-covered committees, which are reported as lump-sum amounts on the disclosure statements; any loans that are deemed contributions because they are outstanding after the last election, taken out after the election, or paid back by a third party; or any bills that are deemed contributions because they are outstanding for more than 90 days, paid back by a third party, or forgiven. Net Expenditures consists of itemized and unitemized expenditure payments, in-kind contributions, transfers to a party or constituted committee, advances, and outstanding liabilities from a campaign's last filed disclosure statement, less expenditure refunds. CFB payments includes total disbursed funds to candidates for the primary, runoff, and general elections.

Notes to Appendices and Data

Data for Non-participants

Totals shown represent cumulative contributions and spending from a candidate's January 15, 1998 filing with the Board of Elections or, if this was unavailable, the latest preceding available statement.

APPENDIX D: CONTRIBUTIONS AND OTHER RECEIPTS (DATA FOR PARTICIPANTS ONLY)

Itemized Contributions includes itemized monetary and in-kind contributions, transfers received from a party or constituted committee, and advances, less forgiven loans. This does not include any surplus funds from previous elections; transfers from non-covered committees, which are reported as lump-sum amounts on the disclosure statements; any loans that are deemed contributions because they are outstanding after the last election, taken out after the election, or paid back by a third party; or any bills that are deemed contributions because they are outstanding for more than 90 days, paid back by a third party, or forgiven. Unitemized Contributions includes contributions of \$99 or less that campaigns are not required to report by contributor. Refunds represents all contributions refunded by the campaign. Total Contributions shows the sum of itemized and unitemized contributions less refunds. Other Receipts shows total income derived from sources other than contributions or loans, such as interest and proceeds from sales or leases, but does not include public funds payments. Funds from Past Elections shows each campaign committee's opening balance in its first submitted disclosure statement. Total shows the sum of total contributions, other receipts, and funds from past elections, if any.

APPENDIX E: CONTRIBUTIONS BY TYPE OF CONTRIBUTOR (DATA FOR PARTICIPANTS ONLY)

This appendix shows itemized monetary and in-kind contributions and advances less refunds and forgiven loans by type of contributor, as reported by the campaigns: *Individuals, Corporations, Employee Organizations*, which includes unions and guilds; *Political Committees*, including candidates' committees and transfers received from a party or constituted committee; *Partnerships, Other Organizations*, which denotes contributions reported by campaigns that were not assigned to one of the preceding five categories; and *Unknown*, which is used for contributions for which no correct category was provided by the candidate. In addition, many unions make contributions through political committees, in which case they will be reported as political committees rather than as employee organizations. This does not include any surplus funds from previous elections; transfers from non-covered committees, which are reported as lump-sum amounts on the disclosure statements; any loans that are deemed contributions because they are outstanding after the last election, taken out after the election, or paid back by a third party; or any bills that are deemed contributions because they are outstanding for more than 90 days, paid back by a third party, or forgiven.

APPENDIX F: LOANS (DATA FOR PARTICIPANTS ONLY)

This appendix shows total loans made and the number of lenders to a campaign. *Number of Lenders* identifies the number of individuals or other entities that made loans to the campaign. *Total Loans* represents the total dollar amount of loans received. *Aggregate amount outstanding* is equal to total loans less any principal and interest repayments and loans forgiven by the lender. Negative outstanding amounts can result from the extent to which accrual of interest causes loan repayments to exceed the original loan amounts. Advances made to a campaign are not shown.

APPENDIX G: PUBLIC FUNDS PAYMENTS (DATA FOR PARTICIPANTS ONLY)

Gross Funds Payable includes the amount of money payable based upon a campaign's valid matching claims and the matching funds limit. Public Funds Withheld includes penalty payments deducted from payment of public funds and other withholdings. Public Funds Disbursed to Candidates is the amount of public funds actually paid to campaigns. Public Funds Returned to CFB includes funds returned to the Board and penalties affirmatively paid to the Board by the campaigns, as opposed to amounts withheld from public funds payments by the Board. Net Amount depicts the total cash flow from the Board to the campaigns.

APPENDIX H: TOTAL EXPENDITURES (DATA FOR PARTICIPANTS ONLY)

This appendix shows itemized and unitemized expenditure payments, in-kind contributions, transfers to a party or constituted committee, advances, and outstanding bills from a campaign committee's last submitted disclosure statement, less expenditure refunds. There are two broad categories of expenditures: exempt and non-exempt. Exempt expenditures are expenditures for certain purposes, such as compliance with the Campaign Finance Act, that do not count toward a participant's expenditure limit. Figures are based upon what is reported to the Board and may not reflect conclusions about the data reached during the audit and enforcement process; spending is shown chronologically and may not reflect an actual allocation between the primary and general elections. In determining the applicable spending limit, an expenditure for goods or services is considered to be made when the goods and services are received, used, or rendered, regardless of the date billed or paid.

Expenditures are shown in six different periods. *Prior to 6/23/94* represents all spending before the Campaign Finance Board rules amendments took effect to establish spending limits for four of five offices prior to the election year. This spending is not subject to the Program's spending limits. *1994-1995* shows subsequent non-exempt and exempt expenditures for the 1994 and 1995 calendar years, and *1996* shows non-exempt and exempt expenditures for the 1996 calendar year. City Council candidates were not subject to any spending limit until 1996. The next following columns show exempt and non-exempt spending from *1/1/97-9/9/97*, *9/10/97-11/4/97*, and *11/5/97-1/11/98* respectively, which approximate the reporting periods for the

primary, general election, and post-election periods. Limits applicable to each period are shown at the bottom of each page.

APPENDIX I: CANDIDATES' FINANCIAL SUMMARY (DATA FOR PARTICIPANTS ONLY)

This appendix summarizes contributions, expenditures, public funds payments, and other campaign activity. Net Contributions includes the total value of itemized and unitemized monetary contributions, in-kind contributions, transfers received from a party or constituted committee, and advances, less refunds and forgiven loans. This does not include any surplus funds from previous elections; transfers from non-covered committees, which are reported as lump-sum amounts on the disclosure statements; any loans that are deemed contributions because they are outstanding after the last election, taken out after the election, or paid back by a third party; or any bills that are deemed contributions because they are outstanding for more than 90 days, paid back by a third party, or forgiven. Number of Contributors includes the number of individuals and other entities which made itemized contributions to the campaign. Other Receipts shows total income derived from sources other than contributions or loans, such as interest and proceeds from sales or leases, but does not include public funds payments. Public Funds Payments includes total disbursed funds to candidates for the primary, runoff, and general elections. Loans Received represents the total dollar amount of loans received. Loans Paid includes all payments of loan principal and interest. Net Expenditures (Except Outstanding) consists of itemized and unitemized expenditure payments, in-kind contributions, transfers to a party or constituted committee, and advances, less expenditure refunds. Outstanding Bills consists of the outstanding liabilities taken from a campaign committee's last filed disclosure statement.

Appendix J

Summary of Advisory Opinions and Board Determinations for the 1997 Election Cycle

ADVISORY OPINIONS

1994-1

Special Election. This opinion explains disclosure requirements and expenditure limits for the special election held in City Council district 51 in 1994. (February 23, 1994)

1994-2

Contribution by Credit Card or Electronic Funds Transfer ("EFT"). This opinion outlines procedures campaigns must follow in receiving contributions by periodic electronic funds transfers or credit card charges. If all criteria of the Campaign Finance Act and Board Rules are met, contributions raised through periodic EFT's and credit card charges may be matched with public funds. (May 12, 1994)

1994-3

Contemporaneous Disclosure. Under a new local law committees authorized by prospective candidates (for offices other than City Council) are required to submit disclosure statements to the Campaign Finance Board each January 15 and July 15 of the four-year election cycle in order to preserve claims for matching funds for contributions received before January 12 in the year of the election. This Advisory Opinion describes how the new law affects rules previously adopted by the Board. (August 18, 1994)

1995-1

Special Election. This opinion sets out deadlines and guidelines for disclosure statement filing for the special election held in City Council district five in January 1996. (December 7, 1995)

1996-1

Exempt Compliance Costs. Certain expenses of complying with City and State election law, and with the Act and Board Rules, are exempt from the Program's expenditure limits. This opinion summarizes expenditures that may be claimed as compliance costs and those that may

not. Campaigns have the burden of showing that an expenditure is exempt and that adequate records have been maintained. (April 4, 1996)

1996-2

Allocation of Expenditures Between Two Committees Authorized for Different

Offices. This opinion addresses the circumstance in which a candidate is running for two offices simultaneously, only one of which falls under the jurisdiction of the Campaign Finance Program, and permits the two committees to share a separate allocation account. The opinion describes the procedure a campaign must follow in allocating and disclosing shared expenditures. (July 18, 1996)

1996-3

Legal Challenge to Results of Election. Legal costs associated with defending a lawsuit challenging the results of an election are exempt expenditures for the election. Such expenses may not be paid for with public funds. Any fundraising conducted by the authorized committee to pay for such legal costs is subject to all Program requirements. (December 12, 1996)

1997-1

Endorsements by Sponsors of Debates. Under the new Debate Law, an organization that makes an endorsement in a primary election for a citywide office remains eligible to sponsor a general election debate among candidates for that same office, as long as that organization does not make an endorsement for the general election before the debate is held. (February 25, 1997)

1997-2

Spending on Television Commercials for a Run-off Primary Election. When a run-off primary election is reasonably anticipated, a campaign may contract before the primary for the production of television commercials for use in the anticipated run-off election. This opinion addresses the requirements applicable to such spending and the use of a separate run-off account when the candidate is in a run-off and, in the alternative, when there is no run-off. (May 15, 1997)

1997-3

Ballot Status Criteria for Inclusion in Debates. The standards for determining whether a candidate in the Campaign Finance Program is on the ballot for purposes of making public funds payments will also apply in determining whether a candidate will be included in a debate. (May 15, 1997)

1997-4

Candidate's Opponent is Off the Ballot. A participating candidate may receive public funds after the candidate's sole opponent is removed from the ballot, provided that the candidate demonstrates qualification for public funds payments under the Act and Board Rules. (June 12, 1997)

Advisory Opinions and Board Determinations

1997-5

Primary Election Debate. A primary election debate is not required when only one candidate in the primary election is participating in the Program. (June 12, 1997)

1997-6

Campaign Finance Act Implications of Changing the Office Sought. This opinion addresses how the Campaign Finance Act's spending limits apply to expenditures made during a campaign for Mayor that is terminated when the candidate decides to run for Borough President instead. These expenditures are presumptively subject to the Borough President spending limits, with certain exceptions outlined in the opinion. (June 24, 1997)

1997-7

"Leading Contenders" for the Debate Program. When only one candidate (or none) has met the "leading contender" criteria for the second general election debate, that debate will not take place. The alternative voter education forum will take place, however, and the Program participant who has met the "leading contender" criteria may appear. (July 24, 1997)

1997-8

Alternative Voter Education Forum. Under the Debate Law, an alternative, nonpartisan voter education program for the second general election debate will take place even if only one candidate for citywide office participating in the Program is required to appear. The sponsoring organization has wide discretion to determine the nature and timing of this alternative program. (September 5, 1997)

1997-9

Joint Fundraising by Two Campaigns Running as a Ticket. This opinion addresses how the Act's contribution limits apply when participating candidates run as a ticket, make joint expenditures, and engage in joint fundraising. These candidates must show they had received enough contributions that do not exceed either candidate's contribution limit to account fully for their "fair share" of joint expenditures. The opinion also outlines requirements relevant for the reimbursement of joint expenditures, regarding the use of public funds, deductions from public funds payments, spending limits, and in-kind contributions. (September 10, 1997)

1997-10

Anticipated Run-off Election Does Not Take Place. This opinion addresses how Program requirements are affected when an anticipated run-off primary election for Mayor will not take place because the Board of Elections announces a primary election winner. (September 18, 1997)

1997-11

Opportunity to Ballot in Primary Election. A candidate participating in the Program, who appears as the only candidate on the ballot in a primary election when an opportunity to ballot petition has been filed, may receive public matching funds for the primary election, should the candidate otherwise meet all Program requirements. (October 9, 1997)

1997-12

Contributions by a Participating Candidate's Committee. This opinion addresses whether public funds will be reduced when a participating candidate makes expenditures to a political club or to another candidate. (October 9, 1997)

1997-13

Candidate in General Election Ends Campaign and Does Not Appear in Debate.

When a participating candidate on the general election ballot asserts, in support of a decision not to appear in a required debate, that his campaign for office has ended, the campaign's expenditures become subject to restrictions that would otherwise first apply after the general election. (November 25, 1997)

1997-14

Spending for a Post-Election Party. A campaign may not pay for costs associated with a party for the purpose of thanking contributors, volunteers, and others who assisted with the election in advance of the required repayment of public funds. (December 9, 1997)

BOARD DETERMINATIONS

1997-1

Messinger v. Giuliani. A complaint was made by Ruth Messinger against Rudolph Giuliani concerning government-financed advertisements (in which Giuliani appeared) announcing the elimination of two-fare transit zones. The Board dismissed the complaint, finding that any improper expenditure of government funds must be addressed in the first instance by an agency with appropriate jurisdiction, such as the Conflicts of Interest Board. (August 14, 1997)

1997-2

Giuliani (1997 Election Contributions). The Board found that a number of contributions, including contributions from "affiliated sources," made over a period of approximately three years to the Giuliani campaign were in excess of the contribution limits. The Board assessed a total penalty of \$220,000 for 134 contributions, for which the campaign documented refunds totaling \$356,651, as directed by the Board. (September 18, 1997)

1997 Election Cycle Chronology of Events

1994

JANUARY

- 1.7.94 Having been appointed to replace Joseph A. O'Hare, S.J. as Chairman on December 30, 1993, by Mayor Dinkins, Thomas J. Schwarz steps down as Chairman of the Campaign Finance Board.
- 1.10.94 Chairman Joseph A. O'Hare, S.J., is re-appointed by Mayor Giuliani.

APRIL

4.26.94 Nonpartisan special election held in Staten Island's 51st Council district to replace outgoing Council member Alfred Cerullo. A total of \$60,339 is distributed in public funds. Vito Fossella wins the election.

MAY

5.16.94 Board adopts rules to establish spending limits in the first two years of the four-year election cycle for candidates for Mayor, Public Advocate, Comptroller, and Borough President. Board also adopts rules providing for contemporaneous filing of semi-annual disclosure statements in order to preserve future matching funds claims for all covered offices.

JUNE

In response to public outcry about the failure of the two leading mayoral candidates to debate in the 1993 election, the Board issues *The Debate Debate*, a report that outlines a proposal to induce candidates to engage in debates, but without tying a debate requirement to the matching funds program.

JULY

7.21.94 Former congressman Bill Green appointed to the Board by Mayor Giuliani to fill an unexpired term for a Board seat previously occupied by former Dean of New York University Law School Robert M. McKay.

AUGUST

8.4.94 The City Council passes a bill modifying contemporaneous disclosure requirements, making it a requirement for preserving matching funds claims for offices other than City Council. This bill is signed into law by the Mayor on August 17 (Local Law No. 37 of 1994).

SEPTEMBER

9.94 The Board's 1994 post-election report, entitled *On The Road To Reform: Campaign Finance in the 1993 New York City Elections*, is released.

OCTOBER

10.18.94 The 51st Council district general election Voter Guide enters the mailstream.

NOVEMBER

11.8.94 A total of \$30,677 is distributed in public funds for a regular election for the 51st Council district in Staten Island. Republican Vito Fossella wins re-election.

1995

JANUARY

1.95 The Board issues *Party Favors*, a report setting forth proposals to address the potential problems when political parties make expenditures that benefit candidates.

APRIL

4.1.95 Bill Green re-appointed to the Board by Mayor Giuliani.

JUNE

6.6.95 Council Speaker appointee Joseph Messina resigns from the Board, when he moves out-of-state.

OCTOBER

10.3.95 The Board adopts new rules to simplify, streamline, and clarify Program requirements, and proposes rules (for public comment) to establish a debate program for candidates seeking citywide office in 1997.

DECEMBER

- **12.7.95** The Board holds a hearing on its proposed debate rules, but then defers to the Council's consideration of a debate bill introduced by Speaker Vallone after the Board's October proposal.
- **12.20.95** The Board's Public Terminal begins operation, enabling the general public to do its own computerized searches of contribution data at the Board's offices.
- **12.21.95** Departing from past practice, the State Board of Elections declares that City campaigns may not submit CFB paper forms in lieu of State BOE forms in their filings with the City Board of Elections.

1996

JANUARY

1.16.96 Special election held in Manhattan's 5th district to replace outgoing Council member Charles Millard. A total of \$81,375 is distributed in public funds. A. Gifford Miller wins the special election.

JUNE

- **6.96** The Board issues *Bundles of Trouble?*, a report setting forth proposals to address issues raised by the use of intermediaries, who deliver contributions to campaigns on behalf of others.
- **6.4.96** Martin Begun appointed to the Board by Council Speaker Vallone to fill an unexpired term.

AUGUST

8.23.96 The 5th Council district primary election Voter Guide enters the mailstream.

SEPTEMBER

9.10.96 Following the special election held in January, A. Gifford Miller wins the Democratic primary election in Manhattan's 5th Council district. A total of \$36,061 is distributed in public funds.

OCTOBER

- **10.10.96** Board adopts additional amendments to its Rules, including those addressing in-kind contributions by political party committees.
- **10.15.96** The 5th Council district general election Voter Guide enters the mailstream.
- 10.16.96 The Board's first-ever Voter Guide dealing exclusively with ballot proposals, "Term Limits and More," enters the mailstream for all New York City voters. The Guide, translated into Spanish and Chinese, provides the text of the term limits ballot proposal, a plain language summary and history of the proposal, statements prepared by the Board highlighting the major arguments on both sides of the proposal, and "pro" and "con" statements from the public. The text of a State ballot proposal is also included.

NOVEMBER

11.5.96 Regular election for the 5th Council district in Manhattan is held. A total of \$27,147 is distributed in public funds. Democrat A. Gifford Miller wins re-election.

DECEMBER

12.2.96 Mayor Giuliani signs the Debate Law, requiring participating candidates on the ballot for citywide office to appear in a series of public debates administered by the Board.

1997

JANUARY

- **1.97** The Board issues its report *Friends in Need: Joint And Independent Spending By Candidates*, which addresses the issue of campaigns making expenditures to benefit other campaigns.
- Based on irregularities first detected by Board auditors, Ron Reale—a participating candidate for Public Advocate in the 1993 elections and former President of the Transit Police Benevolent Association ("TPBA")—and Richard Hartman are indicted on charges that they participated in a scheme to defraud the Campaign Finance Board by submitting fraudulent claims for public matching funds. Further investigations by the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Southern District of New York lead to the additional indictments of lawyers James Lysaght and Peter Kramer in connection with a scheme to charge the TPBA inflated legal fees and provide kickbacks to Reale and Hartman.

FEBRUARY

2.18.97 Federico Perez wins the special election held in the 17th Council district in the Bronx to replace outgoing Council member David Rosado. There are three Program participants, but only one candidate ultimately appears on the ballot. No public funds are distributed in this election.

APRIL

- **4.29.97** The Debate Law receives pre-clearance under the Voting Rights Act from the U.S. Department of Justice.
- **4.30.97** Deadline for candidates seeking a party nomination to join the Program for the 1997 elections. One hundred eighty-five candidates join by this date. An additional five candidates who are not seeking a party nomination ultimately join the Program.

MAY

5.13.97 Fernando Ferrer abandons mayoral race to seek re-election as Bronx Borough President.

John O'Hara is convicted of seven election and penal law felonies in connection with his 1993 campaign for City Council.

5.20.97 The Board releases computerized expenditure reports for 35 Program participants who filed contemporaneously.

JUNE

- **6.1.97** Board member James I. Lewis, a Council Speaker appointee whose term expired on March 31, 1994, resigns from the Board.
- **6.2.97** Disclosure statements due for participants who had campaign finance activity prior to January 12, 1997 but did not file pre opt-in disclosure statements.
- **6.5.97** Campaign Finance Board releases computerized contribution and spending reports for 20 Program participants.
- **6.26.97** Schedule and sponsors announced at a press conference for "Debates '97," the city's first mandatory debate program for municipal candidates.

JULY

7.15.97 Disclosure statements due for all Program participants for the 1997 elections.

- **7.22.97** The Board's World Wide Web site goes online.
- **7.24.97** The Board distributes first payment of \$2,205,638 in public matching funds for the 1997 primary elections.
- **7.25.97** As part of his sentence, John O'Hara (convicted on May 13, 1997), is ordered by Kings County Supreme Court Justice Priscilla Hall to pay to the Board full reparations for the \$9,192 he received in public funds, as well as a civil penalty of \$5,000.

AUGUST

- **8.7.97** The Board distributes \$94,695 in public matching funds to candidates for the primary election.
- Ruth Messinger, stating it lacks jurisdiction over the matter. The complaint against the Giuliani campaign asserted that government-paid advertisements featuring Mayor Giuliani that aired during the election campaign constituted an in-kind contribution by the City of New York subject to the limits of the Program.

The Board distributes \$296,294 in public matching funds to candidates for the primary election.

8.19.97 Democratic mayoral candidates Sal Albanese, Ruth Messinger, Eric Ruano-Melendez, and Al Sharpton participate in the first debate ever held under the City's new Debate Law. The debate is televised on New York 1 News and rebroadcast on Crosswalks.

The Board distributes \$16,072 in public matching funds to candidates for the primary election.

- **8.20.97** Governor George Pataki signs a bill into law requiring electronic filing of campaign finance information by candidates and committees required to file with the State Board of Elections—including candidates for State-wide office and the State legislature—beginning in 1999. (The Campaign Finance Board's requirement for electronic filings by participants using computers to generate disclosure statements was first instituted in the 1993 elections.)
- **8.21.97** The Board distributes \$13,746 in public matching funds to candidates for the primary election.
- **8.28.97** The Board distributes \$157,857 in public matching funds to candidates for the primary election.

SEPTEMBER

- **9.4.97** Roland Rogers, a candidate on the Democratic mayoral primary ballot who is not in the Campaign Finance Program, files a lawsuit against the Board seeking inclusion in the primary mayoral debates.
- **9.5.97** New York County Supreme Court Justice Robert Lippman rules against Rogers' claim, and on application to the Appellate Division he is again denied relief.

The Board distributes \$699,648 in public matching funds to candidates for the primary election.

- **9.7.97** Second mandatory primary debate for mayoral candidates is held. It is televised on WABC-TV and rebroadcast on Crosswalks and WNET.
- **9.9.97** PRIMARY ELECTION
- 9.11.97 Initial reports of the vote count in the Democratic primary election indicate that Ruth Messinger received just under 40 percent of the vote. With no candidate reaching the 40 percent mark, the top two candidates—Ruth Messinger and Al Sharpton—prepare for a run-off election. This triggers two additional debates, increases the contribution limits for the two run-off contestants, and increases the spending limits for all participating mayoral candidates.

The Board distributes \$80,146 in public matching funds to candidates for the primary election.

9.15.97 Ruth Messinger and Al Sharpton participate in the first-ever mandatory primary runoff debate for Mayor. It is televised on New York 1 News and rebroadcast on Crosswalks.

The Board distributes \$320,402 in public matching funds to the Messinger campaign for the run-off election.

- **9.17.97** The run-off primary is called off after the Board of Elections determines Messinger received over 40 percent of the vote for the primary election. The second run-off debate is canceled.
- **9.18.97** The Board meets to hear the Giuliani campaign's challenge to the penalty assessment recommended by CFB staff for accepting over-the-limit contributions. The Board decides unanimously to impose a penalty of \$220,000.

Joseph Erazo is appointed to the Board by Mayor Giuliani to replace Vaughn C. Williams, whose term expired March 31, 1997.

The Board adopts rules establishing a spending limit for City Council candidates in the first two years of the four-year election cycle.

- **9.25.97** Shoghi Fret, Jules Polonetsky, and Mark Green participate in the first-ever mandatory general election debate for Public Advocate. It is televised on New York 1 News and rebroadcast on Crosswalks. The Board distributes \$1,569,403 in public matching funds in first general election payment.
- **9.26.97** The Board distributes \$6,885 in public matching funds for the general election.
- **9.29.97** Alan Hevesi, Wendy Lyons, and Genevieve Torres participate in the first-ever mandatory general election debate for Comptroller. It is televised on New York 1 News and rebroadcast on Crosswalks.

OCTOBER

- 10.7.97 City Council candidate Stephen Fiala, having attempted unsuccessfully to opt in after the April 30th deadline, files a lawsuit against the Board seeking inclusion in the Program.
- 10.9.97 Rudolph Giuliani, Ruth Messinger, and Olga Rodriguez participate in the first-ever mandatory general election debate for Mayor. It is televised on New York 1 News and rebroadcast on Crosswalks and WNET.

The Board distributes \$461,761 in public matching funds for the general election.

- **10.17.97** New York County Supreme Court Justice George B. Daniels rules against Stephen Fiala's request to be included in the Program.
- **10.21.97** The Board distributes \$63,776 in public matching funds for the general election.
- **10.26.97** General election debate alternate forum for Mayor is held. It is televised on WABC-TV.
- **10.27.97** Annemarie McAvoy and Alan Hevesi participate in the second leading contender debate for Comptroller, televised on New York 1 News and rebroadcast on Crosswalks.
- **10.28.97** General election debate alternate forum for Comptroller is held, televised on New York 1 News.
- 10.29.97 Rudolph Giuliani and Ruth Messinger participate in the mayoral debate for leading contenders, televised on WABC-TV and re-broadcast on Crosswalks, WNET, and C-SPAN. The Giuliani campaign is assessed a penalty of \$22,930 for violating the Program's contribution limits.

10.30.97 The Board distributes \$443,346 in public matching funds for the general election. General election debate alternate forum for Public Advocate is held, televised on New York 1 News.

NOVEMBER

11.4.97 GENERAL ELECTION

11.20.97 Program participant Ernest Emmanuel is indicted for obstruction of justice in connection with his attempts to thwart a federal probe into mail fraud allegations involving his campaign's filings with the CFB.

DECEMBER

12.15.97 The Board holds the first of two days of public hearings on the 1997 elections.

1998

JANUARY

- **1.1.98** Inauguration day.
- **1.25.98** City Council Speaker Peter Vallone and Public Advocate Mark Green introduce legislation in the City Council that would prohibit candidates who receive public matching funds from accepting corporate contributions.
- **1.26.98** Ron Reale and his three co-defendants are convicted of crimes stemming from their January 1997 indictment.

FEBRUARY

2.25.98 Chairman O'Hare presents campaign finance reform package at City Council hearings. The proposal would reduce the contribution limits, change the matching rate to 3-for-1 up to \$250, lower the threshold for receiving public funds, and prohibit all organizational contributions (with the exception of PACs, which would have to file disclosure statements with the Board). It would also require electronic filing for all but the smallest campaigns, and grant the Board authority to set the deadline for joining the Program.

MARCH

3.18.98 The New York City Council passes resolution No. 133, calling on the State BOE (1) to implement a computer system that would allow campaigns using C-SMART® or the CFB's alternate format specifications to file by electronic means at the State BOE

and (2) to accept CFB hard-copy forms at the City BOE from candidates for the five offices covered by the Campaign Finance Act.

3.31.98 A decision made by the State BOE in December 1995 not to allow acceptance of CFB hard-copy forms at the City BOE is partially reversed when the State BOE agrees that City campaigns may submit C-SMART® printouts in lieu of State forms, as long as the printouts include three separate monetary contributions forms.

Chairman O'Hare is re-appointed by Mayor Giuliani.

JUNE

- **6.98** Mayoral appointee Joseph Erazo resigns from the Board after accepting the position of Executive Director of Correctional Health Services at the Health and Hospitals Corporation.
- **6.30.98** Ron Reale sentenced to seven years and Richard Hartman to five years for, among other things, scheming to defraud the Campaign Finance Board.

JULY
