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



FINAL BOARD DETERMINATION – EC2013 CAMPAIGN

The New York City Campaign Finance Board ("Board"), at a meeting held on August 13, 2015, made the following final determination concerning the Danielle M. De Stefano 2013 Campaign ("Campaign"):

The Board determined that the Campaign shall receive additional Public Funds as follows:

Type of Payment	Amount
1. Documented Outstanding Liabilities ¹	\$400
2. Unpaid Public Funds Claims ²	\$3,450
3. Qualified Expenditure Surplus ³	\$4,067.62

¹ This Amount represents the Campaign's liabilities reported in the Statement 16 disclosure statement that are documented as still outstanding. The Board disburses public funds in whole dollar amounts.

Candidate ID Number: 1736-P

² This Amount is the difference between the Campaign's valid matchable contributions multiplied by the applicable matching factor and the amount the Campaign has already been paid, and takes into account recommended auditing adjustments, if any.

The Documented Outstanding Liabilities Amount of \$400 is the smallest Amount. Accordingly, the Board determined that the Committee named above shall receive an additional payment of \$400 in public funds.

You may challenge a public funds calculation in a petition for Board reconsideration within thirty days of the date of the Final Audit Report as set forth in Board Rule 5-02(a). However, the Board will not consider the petition unless the Campaign submits new information and/or documentation and shows good cause for its previous failure to provide this information or documentation.

You may also challenge this final determination, within four months, in the New York State Supreme Court pursuant to Article 78 of the Civil Practice Law and Rules.
