1. Making improper post-election expenditures

No Penalty

After an election and before repaying leftover campaign funds to the Board, Program participants may spend campaign funds only to pay for campaign-related expenses incurred in the preceding election and for “routine activities involving nominal cost associated with winding up a campaign and responding to the post-election audit.” *See* Admin. Code §§ 3-702(21), 3-710; Board Rules 1-03(a), 5-03(e)(2). Further, “an expenditure for goods or services is made when the goods or services are received, used, or rendered, regardless when payment is made.” Board Rule 1-08(b).

The Campaign reported \$1,292.42 of impermissible post-election expenditures for credit card processing debit fees.

The Board did not assess a penalty for this violation.
