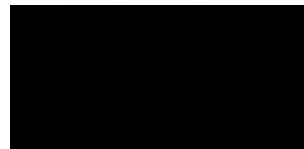
The New York City Campaign Finance Board (the “CFB” or “Board”) has completed its review of the 2023 Transition and Inauguration Entity of Yusef Salaam (the “TIE”) and one issue was noted.

Press reports indicated that the TIE’s inauguration reception included light refreshments served by a local small business. The TIE did not report any catering-related expenditures and/or in-kind donations. A review of the TIE’s bank account activity indicated that the TIE did not spend any funds on catering for its inauguration, suggesting that if the press reports are accurate, the TIE received an in-kind donation. CFB staff raised this issue with the TIE, but the TIE did not respond. Therefore, the source of the purported refreshments remains unresolved.

Notwithstanding this issue, the CFB has determined that the TIE demonstrated substantial compliance with the Campaign Finance Act and Board Rules. This concludes our review of the TIE and a response to this letter is not required. Note that the TIE is required to maintain its records for six years from the date of its registration.
