Based on a review of documents submitted and information disclosed to the New York City Campaign Finance Board (the “CFB” or “Board”) by the 2025 Transition and Inauguration Entity of Brad Hoylman-Sigal (the “TIE”), the CFB has determined that the TIE demonstrated substantial compliance with the Campaign Finance Act and Board Rules.

This concludes our review of the TIE and a response to this letter is not required. Note that the TIE is required to maintain its records for five years from the date of its registration. *See* Board Rule 13-04(d).
