## CERTIFIED STATEMENT OF ACTIVE CANDIDACY

*To be submitted by candidates who lost the primary election and are seeking public funds for the general election*

A participating candidate who lost the primary election but remains on the ballot for the general election must submit a *certified signed statement* to the Campaign Finance Board (CFB) before the candidate may be eligible to receive any public funds. The candidate must attest that he or she will still actively campaign for office, as set forth in the New York City Campaign Finance Act. ([See Administrative Code §3-705\(10\).](#))

### ELIGIBILITY

Participating candidates who lost the primary and who attest that they will actively campaign for office must have already submitted petitions for a different party line and must appear on the general election ballot on that line. Write-in candidates are *not* eligible for public funds payments. In addition, participating candidates who have endorsed or publicly support their general election opponent are not eligible for public funds.

### REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

**The participating candidate must provide documentation demonstrating that s/he will actively campaign for office. The documentation must show campaign activity such as raising and spending funds for the general election, seeking endorsements, and broadly soliciting votes. The CFB must be able to verify the truthfulness of any documentation provided.**

### POSSIBLE DOCUMENTATION

- Your disclosure statement with additional contributions solicited in the general election period;
- Evidence of specific general election expenditures such as payments for campaign literature for the general election, and/or extensions of employment and rental agreements through the general election period;
- Evidence of new or continued endorsements; and
- Copies of campaign literature specific to the general election or evidence of campaign mailings in the general election period to indicate that the campaign is broadly soliciting votes.

### DEADLINE

The certified statement must be completed and signed by the candidate. The form and supporting documentation must be submitted via email to [documents@nyccfb.info](mailto:documents@nyccfb.info) or hand delivery to the CFB by September 22, 2017 to be considered for the first public funds payment of the 2017 general election **or** by October 6, 2017 to be considered for the second public funds payment of the 2017 general election.

**If the Board does not receive a certified statement and proof that the candidate is actively campaigning by October 6, 2017, the candidate will not be eligible to receive a general election public funds payment.**
