

ranked choice voting is here!

New York City will use Ranked Choice Voting in the June 22nd citywide Primary election.

You can now rank up to five candidates in order of preference, instead of choosing just one.

Key dates for the primary election:

May 28: Voter registration deadline

June 7*: Absentee ballot request deadline

June 12–20: Early voting


June 22: Deadline to submit absentee ballot in person or by mail

June 22: Primary Election Day

* The deadline is June 15 as of print time. Governor Cuomo may sign a bill changing the deadline to June 7. We recommend requesting your ballot early.


Offices on the ballot using Ranked Choice Voting:

- City Council





Step 1: Pick your 1st choice candidate and completely fill in the oval next to their name under the first column.

Step 3: You can rank up to five candidates. You can still vote for only one candidate if you prefer. Ranking other candidates does not harm your 1st choice.
