STUDENT VOTER REGISTRATION DAY 2018 SOCIAL MEDIA GUIDELINES

New York City's Student Voter Registration Day (SVRD) is a single-day program that educates students about the importance of voting and civic engagement and registers them to vote. Through interactive discussion, SVRD facilitators encourage students to explore the issues that are most important to them, challenging them to think critically about how these issues are dealt with at the public policy level in order to help connect voting to their everyday lives.

This year, NYC Votes is working alongside the New York City Department of Education and the Office of the Mayor to plan and implement the fifth installment of SVRD. Our partners include the New York City Board of Elections and the New York Immigration Coalition. Community-based organizations, volunteers, and teachers are being recruited to give the SVRD presentation in 450 high schools across all five boroughs.

NYC Votes is the nonpartisan voter engagement initiative of the New York City Campaign Finance Board (CFB), which administers the city's Campaign Finance Program. NYC Votes produces the city's official Voter Guide and the "I Voted" sticker.
