I applied for an absentee ballot on June 5, 8 days before the deadline to apply. I received confirmation on June 11 that the application was processing. As June 23 approached, my husband and I began to call and track the progress and were told that it was processing. On June 23 we had still not received the ballot. When we called that day, we were told that they had not even been dispatched to our region until the day before (June 22). I received the ballot on June 25 and sent it in on the 26th. I was denied the right to vote and it is clear it was a conscious effort and decision to do so by not sending ballots until the day before the election. It is illegal and must be rectified.
