For absentee applications received by **email**, fax or telephone, the deadline is close-of-business on June 16th.

Yet, I received neither a confirmation of receipt nor my absentee ballot. I was not able to go to the polls in person and I feel I was denied my rights as a voter.

What is being done to ensure this never happens again?
