I submitted my absentee ballot application online via email and received a response on May 16 stating: "Your application has been received and will be processed in the order that it was received."

On June 19, I called the Bronx BOE to inquire about my ballot as family and friends had started to receive theirs. I was told that there was no record of my application in the system. I asked the representative to check on the status of my husband's application; he had submitted his online the week prior and that was on record. He received his ballot a couple of days before primary day. I was told that my options were to do early voting at the Bronx BOE, which would require me taking the subway, or go to my normal polling place on primary day.

I went to my normal polling place where several poll workers were not wearing masks correctly (around their necks, their noses out, etc.) When I checked the mail on Wednesday, June 24, my ballot was there.
